Pantomime reminder

A deserved 5-0 lead was quickly gained within the first ten minutes of play. With the game out of reach, Dinglewell started the second in much better shape and managed to contain an Elmbridge team desperate to score more goals. The final score was 0-6 Elmbridge, a deserved victory and an enjoyable game for all despite the heavy loss. The next game is Upton at home next Thursday.

On Thursday 21st November, the Dinglewell Girls Football team went to Oxstalls Sports Park to participate in the GPSFA Girls' League Play-Offs. We kicked off the tournament with a 1:0 win against Hempsted which was a strong team. Our second game was versus Churchdown, which we also managed to win, with Flo T. scoring a goal right before the final whistle! Even though we drew our third game against Finlay, we had enough points to go into the Semi Finals. The girls faced tough opponents from Field Court and unfortunately we lost our first ever match in the League, with a 0:1 score.
